

**NASCAR Powerball Playoff™  
Terminal-Based Lottery Game  
Second-Chance Drawing Rules  
From the Pennsylvania Lottery  
May 2, 2025  
[FINAL]**

1. *Second-Chance Drawing:* The NASCAR Powerball Playoff™ Second-Chance Drawing (“Drawing”) from the Pennsylvania Lottery (“Lottery”) for qualifying terminal-based Lottery game tickets.

(a) *Qualifying tickets:* Powerball terminal-based Lottery tickets purchased from a licensed Lottery retailer from May 6, 2025 through June 5, 2025 and imprinted with a web-code (“Qualifying Tickets”) are eligible for entry into the Drawing. Terminal-based Lottery game tickets purchased via <https://www.PAiLottery.com> are not eligible for entry into the Drawing.

(b) *Participation and entry:*

(1) Entrants must have a registered lottery account in order to participate in the Drawing. To create a lottery account, visit <https://www.pailottery.com>. Creating a lottery account is free.

(2) A registered lottery account holder is subject to the iLottery regulations and specifically agrees to be bound by the iLottery terms and conditions located at

<https://www.pailottery.com/signup/terms-and-conditions/>, as well as any related policies.

(3) To establish a lottery account, players must provide the following information:

- (i) The player's name as it appears on a valid government-issued identification or tax documents;
- (ii) The player's date of birth;
- (iii) The entire or last four digits of the player's Social Security Number, or comparable equivalent;
- (iv) The player's address;
- (v) The player's telephone number;
- (vi) The player's email address;
- (vii) Any other information established by the Lottery to be necessary to verify the age and identity of the player.

(4) An individual may be required to provide additional information or documentation, as set forth in the iLottery terms and conditions, to establish a lottery account or register for iLottery. The information may be used for iLottery registration or to confirm information provided by that individual during the registration process.

(5) To enter the Drawing, entrants must submit the identifying information from at least one Qualifying Ticket

via the Drawing's promotional web site, available at <https://www.palottery.com>, or the Lottery's official mobile application, during the entry period. The identifying information from a Qualifying Ticket may be submitted only once in the Drawing. Entries will automatically be awarded at the time of successful submission of a Qualifying Ticket. No other method of submission will be accepted. Entries submitted using any other method, including entries mailed or hand-delivered to the Lottery, are not valid and will be disqualified.

(6) Each entry must be complete and the information supplied by the entrant must be accurate. Incomplete entries cannot be submitted.

(7) Only one claimant per entry allowed.

(8) Entrants must be 18 years of age or older.

(9) Players may submit the identifying information from an unlimited number of Qualifying Tickets in the Drawing.

(10) Once an entry has been submitted it cannot be withdrawn or changed.

## *2. Drawing description:*

(a) The Lottery will conduct one NASCAR Powerball Playoff™ Second-Chance Drawing for terminal-based Qualifying

Tickets entered into the Drawing. All time references are Eastern Prevailing Time.

(b) All entries received after 4:59:59 a.m. May 6, 2025 through 11:59:59 p.m. June 5, 2025, will be entered into the Drawing tentatively scheduled to be held between June 6, 2025 and June 20, 2025.

(c) The entry period for the Drawing will be posted to the Lottery's publicly accessible web site at <https://www.palottery.com>.

(d) The number of entries an entrant will receive for the Drawing is determined by the purchase price of the Qualifying Ticket entered. For example, an entrant who submits the web-code from a Powerball Qualifying Ticket with a purchase price of \$3.00 will receive three entries into the Drawing.

(e) Players may review prizes won and their entries for the Drawing via the Drawing's promotional web site.

3. *Prizes available to be won, determination of winners, and odds of winning:*

(a) The prize entitlements described below are subject to all restrictions and limitations described in section 4, or mentioned anywhere else in these rules.

(b) Lottery will conduct one Drawing from among all the entries received during the entry period as described in section 2(b).

(c) The first through the thirty-fifth entries selected in the Drawing will be winning entries and the entrants who submitted those winning entries shall each be entitled to a prize of \$2,000 and one entry into the Multistate Lottery Organization's ("MUSL") Drawing for the 16 NASCAR Powerball Playoff™ Semi-Finalists, as described in section 4.

(d) The number of winning entries to be selected for the Drawing will be posted to the Lottery's publicly accessible web site.

(e) The odds of winning in the Drawing depend upon the number of entries received for the Drawing.

(f) A computer-generated randomizer will be used to select the Drawing winners.

4. *Description of the NASCAR Powerball Playoff™ Drawing Series:*

(a) MUSL will conduct one drawing to determine 16 Semi-Finalists in the NASCAR Powerball Playoff™ Drawing on August 7, 2025. MUSL will publicly announce the winners on August 23, 2025, during the race held at the Daytona International Speedway in Daytona Beach, FL. The 16 Semi-

Finalists will win the chance to participate in the NASCAR Powerball Playoff™ Drawing Series as described below.

(b) The 16 NASCAR Powerball Playoff™ Semi-Finalists will participate in a series of elimination round drawings, as described below, until four Finalists remain.

(1) On August 27, 2025, MUSL will select 12 out of 16 Semi-Finalists to proceed to the next Drawing. MUSL will publicly announce the winners on September 13, 2025, during the race held at Bristol Motor Speedway in Bristol, TN. The four Semi-Finalists who do not advance shall each be entitled to a prize of \$2,500.

(2) On September 17, 2025, MUSL will select 8 out of the 12 remaining Semi-Finalists to proceed to the next Drawing. MUSL will publicly announce the winners on October 5, 2025, during the race held at Charlotte Motor Speedway in Concord, NC. The four Semi-Finalists who do not advance shall each be entitled to a prize of \$5,000.

(3) On October 8, 2025, MUSL will select four out of the eight remaining Semi-Finalists. MUSL will publicly announce the winners (also referred to as "Finalists") on October 26, 2025, during the race held at Martinsville Speedway in Martinsville, VA. The four winners shall each be entitled to a prize of the NASCAR Championship Weekend Trip Prize Package,

as described in section 4(d), below. The four Semi-Finalists who do not win the Trip Prize Package shall each be entitled to a prize of \$7,500, less required income tax withholding.

(d) *NASCAR Championship Weekend Trip Prize Package description:* Each NASCAR Championship Weekend Trip Prize Package shall consist of a four-day, three-night VIP trip for the winner and up to one guest to Phoenix, AZ, from approximately October 31, 2025 to November 3, 2025. During the Trip Prize, the four Finalists will participate in a Drawing to win one (1) Grand Prize of \$1,000,000, less required income tax withholding. The three Finalists who do not win the Grand Prize will be awarded a prize of \$10,000, less required income tax withholding. The specific elements of the NASCAR Championship Weekend Trip Prize Package, including transportation, lodging, gifts and events, are described in Addendum 1, Prize Terms and Conditions, to these rules.

5. Prize Package restrictions:

(a) There is no cash option for the NASCAR Championship Weekend Trip Prize Package.

(b) The Lottery is not responsible for injury, loss or damage to person or property in connection with the NASCAR Championship Weekend Trip Prize Package.

(c) NASCAR Championship Weekend Trip Prize Package restrictions:

(1) Lottery is not responsible for NASCAR Championship Weekend Trip Prize Package fulfillment. Lottery disclaims any responsibility for any and every occurrence with respect to fulfillment or enjoyment of the NASCAR Championship Weekend Trip Prize Package.

2) All other Trip Prize Package Restrictions are described in Addendum 1, Prize Terms and Conditions, to these rules.

6. Delinquent Support Offset: If the Department of Human Services, pursuant to 23 Pa.C.S.A. § 4308, the Department of Revenue or the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts, pursuant to 72 P.S. § 215, determines that a prize winner is a delinquent support obligor as provided in 23 Pa.C.S.A. § 4308 or 72 P.S. § 215, the amount of any arrearages shall be deducted from the drawing prize. After the delinquent support obligation is met, the Prize Package winner will receive the remaining portion of the drawing prize, if any, which shall be fulfilled according to Lottery procedure.

7. Prize claim procedures:

(a) Winners of any prize awarded in the Drawing will be contacted by email by the Lottery to initiate the prize claim procedure.

(b) Winners will have seven (7) business days from the date they are notified by the Lottery, pursuant to this section, to claim their prizes. In order to claim their prizes, winners must respond to the Lottery's email regarding prize claim procedure and must submit a properly completed prize claim form within seven (7) business days from the date they are notified by the Lottery. Failure to comply with the prize claim requirements as set forth herein, for any reason, shall result in the winner forfeiting their right to receive the prize. An alternate winner will be awarded the respective prize, according to Lottery procedure.

(c) By entering into the Drawing, players agree to be bound by these rules and the prize claim requirements set forth herein, and expressly waive any claim against the Lottery for a prize not awarded in conformance with these rules.

8. Drawing restrictions:

(a) To be eligible to participate in the Drawing, entrants must have complied with the requirements of these rules and Lottery procedure.

(b) The Lottery is not responsible for late, lost or misdirected entries not entered into the Drawing. The Lottery is not responsible for entries that are not entered into the Drawing because of incompatible internet browsers, mobile Lottery application failure or other technical issues. The Lottery is not responsible for entries not entered due to delays in creating a lottery account or the inability to create a lottery account. If an entry is selected as a winner and rejected or otherwise disqualified during or following the Drawing, the Lottery will select one entry to replace the rejected or otherwise disqualified entry in accordance with these rules and Lottery procedure. Entries not received for any other reason will not be considered entries.

(c) If any discrepancy exists between these rules and any material describing the Drawing, these rules shall govern.

(d) Employees of the Lottery, 9Rooftops Marketing, LLC (formerly known as MARC USA, LLC), MUSL, Scientific Games, Inc., MDI Entertainment, LLC (collectively "SG"), and their subcontractors, or a spouse, child, brother, sister or parent residing as a member of the same household in the principal place of residence of any such person are not eligible to participate in the Drawing. Offer void where prohibited or restricted.

(e) The Lottery reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel or suspend the Drawing and change these rules if the Drawing cannot be conducted as planned due to errors in these rules or advertising, unauthorized intervention, tampering, fraud, technical errors, viruses, worms, bugs or any other cause that, in the Lottery's sole judgment, could corrupt or impair the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Drawing.

(f) All entries shall be subject to verification by the Lottery.

(g) The Lottery reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify an entrant found to be tampering with the operation of the Drawing or to be acting in violation of these rules or applicable law.

(h) The Drawing is governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Applicable laws and regulations apply.

(i) Final determination of winners will be made by the Secretary, whose judgment will be final and binding.

(j) A prize awarded in the Drawing to a person who dies before receiving the prize shall be paid according to 61 Pa. Code § 811.16 (relating to prizes payable after death of a prize winner).

(k) A winner is responsible for all taxes arising from or in connection with any prize won.

(l) A player may only win the prize for which the player is first selected in the Drawing. Subsequent entries, from the same individual, selected in the Drawing will be disqualified and one replacement entry will be selected.

(m) Prizes are not transferrable.

(n) Other restrictions may apply.
