Terminal-Based Lottery Game
Second-Chance Drawing Rules
From the Pennsylvania Lottery
08/01/2025
[FINAL]

1. Second-Chance Drawing: The Big Game Second-Chance Drawing ("Drawing") from the Pennsylvania Lottery ("Lottery") for qualifying terminal-based Lottery game tickets to be entered for a chance to win an Ultimate Trip & Prize Package to Pro Football's Biggest Game of the Year ("Trip Prize"), as described in section 4.

(a) Qualifying tickets: PICK 2; PICK 3; PICK 4; PICK 5; Treasure Hunt; Cash 5 with Quick Cash; Match 6 Lotto; Cash4Life®; Powerball®; Mega Millions®, Keno and Derby Cash terminal-based Lottery tickets purchased from a licensed Lottery retailer from August 19, 2025 through October 23, 2025 and imprinted with a web-code ("Qualifying Tickets") are eligible for entry in the Drawing. Terminal-based Lottery game tickets purchased via <https://www.PAiLottery.com> are not eligible for entry in the Drawing.

(b) Participation and entry:

(1) Entrants must have a registered lottery account in order to participate in the Drawing. To create a

lottery account, visit <https://www.pailottery.com>. Creating a lottery account is free.

(2) A registered lottery account holder is subject to the iLottery regulations and specifically agrees to be bound by the iLottery terms and conditions located at <https://www.pailottery.com/signup/terms-and-conditions/>, as well as any related policies.

(3) To establish a lottery account, players must provide the following information:

- (i) The player's name as it appears on a valid government-issued identification or tax documents;
- (ii) The player's date of birth;
- (iii) The entire or last four digits of the player's Social Security Number, or comparable equivalent;
- (iv) The player's address;
- (v) The player's telephone number;
- (vi) The player's email address;
- (vii) Any other information established by the Lottery to be necessary to verify the age and identity of the player.

(4) An individual may be required to provide additional information or documentation, as set forth in the iLottery terms and conditions, to establish a lottery account or

register for iLottery. The information may be used for iLottery registration or to confirm information provided by that individual during the registration process.

(5) To enter the Drawing, entrants must submit the identifying information from at least one Qualifying Ticket via the Drawing's promotional web site, available at <https://www.palottery.com>, or the Lottery's official mobile application, during the entry period. The identifying information from a Qualifying Ticket may be submitted only once in the Drawing. Entries will automatically be awarded at the time of successful submission of a Qualifying Ticket. No other method of submission will be accepted. Entries submitted using any other method, including entries mailed or hand-delivered to the Lottery, are not valid and will be disqualified.

(6) Each entry must be complete and the information supplied by the entrant must be accurate. Incomplete entries cannot be submitted.

(7) Only one claimant per entry allowed.

(8) Entrants must be 18 years of age or older.

(9) Players may submit the identifying information from an unlimited number of Qualifying Tickets in the Drawing.

(10) Once an entry has been submitted it cannot be withdrawn or changed.

2. Drawing description:

(a) The Lottery will conduct one The Big Game Second-Chance Drawing from among all terminal-based Lottery game Qualifying Tickets entered into the Drawing. All time references are Eastern Prevailing Time.

(b) All entries received after 4:59:59 a.m. August 19, 2025, through 11:59:59 p.m. October 23, 2025, will be entered into the Drawing tentatively scheduled to be held between October 24, 2023, and November 7, 2025.

(c) The entry period for the Drawing will be posted to the Lottery's publicly accessible web site at <https://www.palottery.com>.

(d) An entrant will receive one entry for each \$0.10 in purchase price for Keno and Derby Cash Qualifying Tickets submitted into the Drawing. An entrant will receive one entry for each \$0.50 in purchase price for each PICK 2, PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5, Treasure Hunt, Cash 5 with Quick Cash, Match 6 Lotto, Cash4Life®, Powerball®, and Mega Millions® Qualifying Ticket submitted into the Drawing. For example, an entrant who submits the web-code from a Keno or a Derby Cash Qualifying Ticket with a purchase price of \$1.00 will receive ten entries into the

Drawing. Similarly, an entrant who submits the web-code from a PICK 2, PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5, Treasure Hunt, Cash 5 with Quick Cash, Match 6 Lotto, Cash4Life®, Powerball®, and Mega Millions® Qualifying Ticket with a purchase price of \$5.00 will receive 10 entries into the Drawing.

(e) Players may review prizes won and their entries for the Drawing via the Drawing's promotional web site.

3. Prizes available to be won, determination of winners, and odds of winning:

(a) The prize entitlements described below are subject to all restrictions and limitations described in section 5 or mentioned anywhere else in these rules.

(b) The Lottery will conduct one Drawing from among all the entries received during the entry period as described in section 2(b).

(c) The first through the fifth entries selected in the Drawing will be winning entries and the entrants who submitted those winning entries shall each be entitled to a prize of one (1) Trip Prize, subject to certain restrictions, as more fully described in section 5.

(d) The number of winning entries to be selected for the Drawing will be posted to the Lottery's publicly accessible web site.

(e) The odds of winning in the Drawing depend upon the number of entries received for the Drawing.

(f) A computer-generated randomizer will be used to select the Drawing winners.

4. Description of the Trip Prize:

(a) Each Trip Prize shall have a total value of \$64,852.16.

(b) The total value of each Trip Prize shall include round-trip, coach-class airfare for two (2) people to an international airport near Santa Clara, CA; one (1) double occupancy hotel room for two (2) people for four (4) nights; ground transportation at destination; \$1,000 spending money; one (1) Welcome Dinner; two (2) tickets to the Pro Football Hall of Fame Merlin Olsen Luncheon; two (2) SBXTRA tickets to the NFL Experience; two (2) tickets to the Official Hall of Fame Pre-Game Tailgate; and two (2) upper deck (or comparable section) tickets to the 2026 Championship Game to be held in Santa Clara, California on February 8, 2026. The total value of each Trip Prize shall also include \$524.64 of state income tax withholding and \$15,564.52 of federal income tax withholding that will be paid by the Lottery on behalf of each prize winner.

(c) Prize claim procedure:

(1) Winners of the Trip Prize will be contacted by email by the Lottery to initiate the prize claim procedure.

(2) Winners will have five (5) business days from the date they are notified by the Lottery, pursuant to section 4(c)(1), to claim their prizes. In order to claim their prizes, winners must respond to the Lottery's email regarding prize claim procedure and must submit a properly completed prize claim form within five (5) business days from the date they are notified by the Lottery, pursuant to section 4(c)(1). Failure to comply with the prize claim requirements as set forth herein, for any reason, shall result in the winner forfeiting his/her right to receive the prize. The Lottery will select one alternate winner to be awarded the respective Trip Prize, according to Lottery procedure.

(3) By entering a ticket into the Drawing, the entrant agrees to be bound by these rules, the prize claim requirements set forth herein, and expressly waives any claim against the Lottery for a prize not awarded in conformance with these rules.

(d) Delinquent support offset:

(1) If the Department of Human Services, pursuant to 23 Pa.C.S.A. § 4308, the Department of Revenue or the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts, pursuant to

72 P.S. § 215, determines that a winner of The Big Game Trip Prize is a delinquent support obligor as provided in 23 Pa.C.S.A. § 4308 or has delinquent state tax obligations or court costs or fees as provided in 72 P.S. § 215, and if the amount of any arrearages shall be \$1,000, or less (i.e., the spending money portion of the Trip Prize), the amount of any arrearages shall be deducted from the spending money portion of The Big Game Trip Prize. After the delinquent support obligation is met, The Big Game Trip Prize winner will receive the remaining portion of the prize and the spending money, if any, which shall be fulfilled according to Lottery procedure.

(2) If the Department of Human Services, pursuant to 23 Pa.C.S.A. § 4308, the Department of Revenue or the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts, pursuant to 72 P.S. § 215, determines that a winner of The Big Game Trip Prize is a delinquent support obligor as provided in 23 Pa.C.S.A. § 4308 or has delinquent state tax obligations or court costs or fees as provided in 72 P.S. § 215, and if the amount of any arrearages shall be greater than \$1,000, the prize winner shall forfeit the prize and shall be considered to have waived their right to receive the prize. In this event, the Lottery will select one entry to replace the forfeited entry in accordance with these rules and Lottery procedure.

5. The Trip Prize restrictions:

(a) In the event a prize described in section 4 is not available, the Lottery may either provide a substitute prize, determined by the Secretary to have an equivalent value to the prize won, or make a cash payment to the winner, in an amount determined by the Secretary to have an equivalent value to the prize won.

(b) Each winner, his or her respective heirs, legal representatives, and assigns, agree to indemnify, defend, release, and discharge the Lottery, its employees, officers, directors, and commissioners, and the National Football Museum, Inc. d/b/a Pro Football Hall of Fame, its employees, officers, directors, and commissioners, from and against any loss, claim, damage, suit, or injury arising out of or relating to these Second-Chance Drawings, acceptance and possession of the Trip Prize, or any action taken pursuant to these Rules. By entering, the winner indemnifies, releases, discharges, and agrees to hold harmless the Lottery, its employees, officers, directors, and commissioners, and the National Football Museum, Inc. d/b/a Pro Football Hall of Fame, its employees, officers, directors, and commissioners, from unanticipated cancellation, suspension, or postponement of the promotion due to natural

disaster, national emergency, or other unforeseen act of God or man.

6. Drawing restrictions:

(a) To be eligible to participate in the Drawing, entrants must have complied with the requirements of these rules.

(b) The Lottery is not responsible for late, lost or misdirected entries not entered into the Drawing. The Lottery is not responsible for entries that are not entered into the Drawing because of incompatible internet browsers, mobile Lottery application failure or other technical issues. The Lottery is not responsible for entries not entered due to delays in creating a lottery account or the inability to create a lottery account. If a Drawing entry is selected as a winner and rejected or otherwise disqualified during or following the Drawing, the Lottery will select one entry to replace the rejected or otherwise disqualified entry in accordance with these rules and Lottery procedure. Entries not received for any other reason will not be considered entries.

(c) If any discrepancy exists between these rules and any material describing the Drawing, these rules shall govern.

(d) Employees of the Pennsylvania Lottery, 9Rooftops Marketing, LLC, Scientific Games, LLC ("SG"), and their

subcontractors, or a spouse, child, brother, sister or parent residing as a member of the same household in the principal place of residence of any such person are not eligible to participate in the Drawing. Offer void where prohibited or restricted.

(e) The Lottery reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel or suspend the Drawing and change these rules if the Drawing cannot be conducted as planned due to errors in these rules or advertising, unauthorized intervention, tampering, fraud, technical errors, viruses, worms, bugs or any other cause that, in the Lottery's sole judgment, could corrupt or impair the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Drawing.

(f) All entries shall be subject to verification by the Lottery.

(g) The Lottery reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify an entrant found to be tampering with the operation of the Drawing or to be acting in violation of these rules or applicable law.

(h) The Drawing is governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Applicable laws and regulations apply.

(i) Final determination of winners will be made by the Secretary, whose judgment will be final and binding.

(j) A prize awarded in the Drawing to a person who dies before receiving the prize shall be paid according to 61 Pa. Code § 811.16 (relating to prizes payable after death of a prize winner).

(k) A winner is responsible for all taxes arising from or in connection with any prize won.

(l) A player may only win the prize for which the player is first selected in the Drawing. Subsequent entries, from the same individual, selected in the Drawing will be disqualified and one replacement entry will be selected.

(m) Prizes are not transferrable.

(n) Other restrictions may apply.
